1.Preliminary Seminar

On May 21, 2015, welcomed about 300 visitors, the Preliminary-Seminar on "The 4th Industrial Revolution is going ahead" was held. Now it is introduced efforts to Robot Revolution realization that have been added to the new growth strategy listed of the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry. And it was introduced in Hannover Messe by the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany to the "Report of Industry 4.0".



2.Press conference and mass media announcements

On December.3, 2014, representatives of companies planning to exhibit at the fair were welcomed to an explanatory presentation, followed by a press conference. Information provided included an outline of the fair and exhibitions, and introductions to key features.
